



Volunteer roles

Whether you have minutes, days or months to spare there are lots of ways to get involved and join the CSW team. Here are some of the roles available, but if you have skills or experience in a particular area that you think we might benefit from, please let us know.

Carers Hub volunteers

The Carers Hub at the RUH is an information and support point for carers and hospital staff run in partnership with BANES Carers Centre. Helping out here is a great opportunity for someone who has some regular time to spare and loves to meet new people. You will talk to the general public, hospital staff and car

Admin support

We are a small charity and rely on volunteers to help out in our busy office. From data entry, general admin duties and answering the phone, there is always plenty to do. If you have office experience or are looking to add to your CV then this could be for you.

Counsellor

We offer carers registered with us free counselling and rely on volunteers to provide this service. Ideally you should be qualified to a minimum of Diploma level, but second year students looking to gain hours may be considered.

Complementary Therapist

Could you provide complementary therapies or beauty treatments? Our pampering sessions provide carers with a short break and time for themselves and are always really popular.

Talk and Support Service Volunteer

A rewarding role offering support to a carer via regular telephone contact. You may have experience of being a carer or have worked in a similar support role.

Event volunteer

We need lots of lovely people who are willing to help out at fundraising and awareness raising events. Setting up and manning stands will be required so a can do attitude and a love of meeting new people is a must.

Community volunteers

We need help in spreading the word about our work and raising awareness about unpaid carers. Distributing newsletters, posters or giving talks for community groups such as the WI or Rotary.

Carers Ambassador

We are looking for people to act as Carer Support Wiltshire representatives in their local parish. This role will include contributing regular articles to parish newsletters, attending local carer cafés and networking events.

Carers Café Facilitator

To facilitate a monthly carers cafe and to promote a welcoming and supportive atmosphere for the attendees. You will help in promoting the café locally and encourage and keep a record of attendance.
